The 2010 Academy on the Road will take place on the campuses of Albright College (Reading, Pennsylvania) and Wake Forest University (Winston-Salem, North Carolina) on Saturday, April 17, 2010. The Academy will start at 11:00am and conclude at 5:00pm.

Academy on the Road is open to any undergraduate member interested in recruitment or new member education. Specifically, all Recruitment Directors, recruitment committee members/team captains and Membership Education Directors (Pledge Educators) should attend. Academy is also open to any chapter-level volunteer such as the GCA, Chapter Council members or prospective Chapter Council members. There is no registration cost to attend Academy on the Road. Lunch will be provided, along with all handouts and conference materials. There will be three separate and distinct tracks offered during Academy on the Road.

Track #1 is a recruitment track geared towards Recruitment Directors (current and future); recruitment committee members; recruitment team captains; and any member interested in helping to grow your chapter. Participants will leave with a detailed recruitment plan and the skills necessary to implement the plan to ensure a successful fall recruitment.

Track #2 is a new member education track geared towards Membership Education Directors (current and future); and those members interested in learning about the new national program and how to implement the program. Participants will leave the program with an understanding of the revised member education program and how to implement the program.

Track #3 is geared towards volunteer advisors (advisors, Chapter Council members, etc) and those who are potentially interested in volunteering. Participants will leave the program with a greater understanding of advisor roles, as well as a tool box of resources to ensure greater success working with the undergraduates.

All three tracks are modified versions of the revised curriculum used at this year Presidents' Academy of Leadership in Indianapolis, Indiana and are designed to be highly interactive and engaging, not lecture.
